***Diana Ewald** updated us on the financial request for the Tournament of Roses Parade Fundraising.

March to the Roses is the fundraising theme. There are many ways we are fundraising.

Lambeau Field concessions: Each person receives \$25.00 in their students account if they work. Goal for Boosters is \$12,000.

Calendar Raffle: Buy a Band calendar for \$20 and you are entered in a raffle to win \$20 cash. Calendars
are being sold at the HS, Sir Speedy, PACE and Wicka's Bar. Goal is \$2,500.00.

Christmas on the Green: December 23rd at Thornberry. Alumni under the direction of Mr. Busch will
perform. Cocktails and hors d'oeuvres will be served. Cost \$30 per person, or \$55. per couple. VIP table for
\$250. Goal is \$2,500,00.

Pennies for Pasadena: Milk jugs will be placed around businesses from January through December 2011.
Goal, \$10,000.00.

Raffle: In Spring, June of 2011, Raffle where each band family will be asked to sell at least 100 tickets.
Tickets will sell for \$5 per ticket or 3 for \$10.00. Prize is \$2,500.00 and will be drawn the night of Concert
on the Concourse. Goal is \$30,000.00.

yards for \$20 each. Money goes into students account. Goal is \$5,000.00.

of the current account. Motion was made to take the money needed from the booster account and motion was
seconded. Mr. Busch added that much of the funds that are in the booster account now are residual funds
from the previous TOR fundraising.
