- * Concern regarding some band students needing to miss practices over the summer for religious conference. Discussing what can be worked out for these students.

Jazz (Mr. Tewart)

- * The Red Raider Jazz group heard back that they did not qualify for the Essential Ellington Competition in New York.
- * Jazz bands will travel to Eau Claire for Jazz festival on April 8-9th.

New Business:

- * **Band O Rama/Chili Luncheon Update:** It has been decided to continue the Chilirific Musicpalooza as we did this year. We have received many positive comments regarding it along with suggestions on how to improve it. The date works well as it does not interfere with Super Bowl Sunday. Barb Stephanie and Ann Kaufman updated us with the financials. It looks like this year brought in approximately \$3000.00 more than last year.
- * **Solo & Ensemble Update:** March 12th is Solo & Ensemble. We have lots of volunteer forms coming in but are still in need of more volunteers. Ray Tauscher is asking for any parents available on Thursday or Friday that could help move pianos. Please sign up on sheet going around. Michelle Baranczyk is heading up concessions. Barb Stephanie is heading up the feeding of the Judges.
- * **Tournament of Roses Fundraising Update (Diana Ewald)**
 - *Schneider National will fully fund our transportation of instruments and baggage out to California. They are considering using a trailer that recognizes the Veterans for this transportation.
 - ***Calendars** sold to date are 200. We made \$1800 on them.
 - ***Corporate Sponsors** - we have 16 so far.
 - ***Restaurant coupons** for Chili's ended today. For the month of March, Figaro's here in Pulaski will offer four different days in which they will give 20% of the purchase to the booster club. Dates are: March 10, 18, 24th and April 1st.
 - ***Pennies for Pasadena** - We have 50 jugs out and around the local businesses. Matt has more jugs so if anyone knows of a business who would be willing to have a jug please let Matt or Diana know. Festival Foods will have a jar at each register for the month of March at the West and Suamico locations.
 - ***Festival Foods Food Stand:** We have secured two dates this summer to have a brat stand. They are Sunday, June 5th at the West side store from 8 am - 7 pm. And Saturday, June 25th, at the Suamico store from 8 am - 7 pm. We will be looking for volunteers to staff this in April. Looking at possibly 4 adults per 4 hour shifts.
 - ***Raffle Tickets:** Raffle tickets will go out to families at Solo & Ensemble. Each family is expected to sell 100 tickets. They are 1/\$5 or 3/\$10. Drawing will take place in June at the Concert on the Concourse.
 - ***Hansen Pizza sales** will be starting in April. We earn a 40% profit on this sale in which 20% goes into Individual student accounts and 20% goes into the general booster account. Bev Heling has offered 40% of sales of any **Avon** orders to the booster club for the month of April.

***Polka with the President** from Pasadena will occur on June 22, 2011 at the MCL parking lot. Some of our local polka bands will be there to perform. On June 23rd at the Concert on the Concourse the president will announce our bid to the parade.

***TOR Clothing sales:** We will need at least 18 more orders to process the first order. We will take orders again in the fall.

* **Lambeau Field Contract:** Julie Maccoux and Diana Ewald will head up this but would like to get a new face on board also. Anyone who might be interested please contact Julie or Diana.

***Election of New Officers:** We have two positions open on the Executive board. One is for Vice-President and the other is for Treasurer.
