Tentative Schedule of Events

Day 1: Thursday, March 14, 2019

- A motor coach and tour escort will be designated for afternoon group pickup at Newark International Airport to transfer to Rockefeller Center. Travelers may also choose to meet the group at Rockefeller Center.
- Visit **St. Patrick's Cathedral**, the most beautiful Gothic cathedral in the New World, built in 1879
- **Dinner - included**
- Walking tour of **Rockefeller Center**: a New York City landmark for over 75 years, located in the heart of Manhattan and home to broadcast studios, dozens of shops and restaurants, and Radio City Music Hall.
- View the magnificent skyline of the Big Apple from the "**Top of the Rock**" at Rockefeller Center
- Check-in to Hilton Newark Airport Hotel; overnight

Day 2: Friday, March 15, 2019

- Breakfast buffet at hotel – included. Transfer to Liberty Island to drop group. Buses to meet at Battery Park in lower Manhattan when group disembarks from Statue Cruises.
- **Statue of Liberty**: Liberty was a gift of friendship from the people of France to the people of the United States, and is a universal symbol of freedom and democracy
- **Visit Ellis Island**, the historical federal immigration processing center
- **Visit the 9/11 Memorial**, a national tribute of remembrance and honor to the 2,983 people killed in the terror attacks of September 11, 2001, and February 25, 1993. View the memorials in St. Paul's Chapel, home of an eight-month volunteer relief effort after 9/11.
- **Enjoy street-side shopping** in the colorful ethnic neighborhoods of **Chinatown & Little Italy**
- **Dinner - included**
- **Attend at Broadway show in the Theatre District!**
- Return to hotel; overnight

Day 3: Saturday, March 16, 2019

- Breakfast buffet at hotel – included; departure for midtown Manhattan
- **Thrill as the Pulaski High School Red Raiders Marching Band perform in the 2019 St. Patrick's Day Parade, celebrating its 258th year!** The parade can be viewed along 5th Avenue between 44th Street and 79th Street from 11:00 a.m. to 5:00 pm.
- **The oldest and largest parade in the Western Hemisphere, the parade is a true spectacle, with more than 150,000 participants marching in the parade. The parade lineup features high school and college marching bands from across the United States and Ireland, plus bagpipe bands, NYPD & FDNY bands, and military bands.**

- Transfer to Lincoln Harbor Marina on the Hudson River to board your breakfast cruise
- **Enjoy breakfast and a narrated cruise** of New York Harbor's historic skyline on the Spirit of New Jersey! Disembark at Chelsea Pier in Manhattan. Chelsea Pier is home to the Food Network and YouTube, with an array of stores and entertainment.
- Free time to shop and tour the exciting, vibrant, and historic Times Square or Fifth Avenue!
- Explore upper Manhattan on your own.
The **Metropolitan Museum of Art** and the **American Museum of Natural History** are adjacent to Central Park. The bus will be available for those who wish to return to the hotel to change clothing; allot 3 hours prior to dinner.
