

Pulaski Music Booster Meeting

Meeting called to order by PCSMB President Lisa Voelker at 7:00pm

Secretary Report (Laura Fenendael-PCSMB Secretary)

- Hard copy of the June minutes (no meeting took place in July) taken by Laura Fenendael, were available for review

Treasurer's Report (Laura Hickson-PCSMB Treasurer)

- PMB account balances are reported as-Checking: \$62,000 Premier CD gone rolled over into checking to help over the cost of the Booster's payments for TOR, Money Market \$32,000, Endowment \$3,000 and \$150 cash box.
- Paid last month: \$38,000 for TOR July payment
- \$24,000 balance in checking after expenses, we will also have approx. an additional \$18,000 in TOR expenses that is not in the budget for the fundraising portion that came out of the regular booster account.
- Discussion with Brenda Brandenburg having a connection with possible free luggage tags to help with additional cost. Also, discussion on TOR pins and the pin exchange and the expense for that, as well as taking school bus instead coach buses to the airports and back.
- Exec. Team will be meeting on Monday 8/15 to determine additional TOR payments.
- We still need your help to raise funds so keep pushing with all needs in all funds.
