**PayPal account had netted about \$360 in donations at this time.

**As it looks we are only going to have to take out about \$25,000 out of the current funds to help cover cost of trip.

**Parents stated that a plaque would be nice to give to the companies that were our top donors for the trip as a form of "thank you" to them along with tickets to our events.
